Artistic Director's Address

Through innovation and collaboration, Eagles Nest transformed Theatre-in-Education over the last twenty years. More than 30% of Victorian schools now book with us each year.

In 2024/25 we began tailoring existing programs for individual schools and rolled out a whole series of new concepts. Our recent partnership with Adland Tours also allowed us to help socio-economically disadvantaged schools to access our work.

New programs included: four creative writing workshops for the VCE Key Frameworks for Ideas, public performances and workshops at the Malthouse, and culturally informed and led Indigenous programs.

In 2026 these initiatives will continue and there is more to come. 1-5 day in-school immersive programs: for text studies, creative writing and learning about aboriginal culture are now available as well as Curated school camps in Australia and overseas.

Get out "on country" to study Aboriginal culture in the community.

Travel to South America (Peru, the Galapagos Islands or Patagonia) to learn about culture, language, environment and natural science.

Head to South Eastasia to dive into wellbeing, creative and mindfulness programs.

Non Text-based Indigenous Programs

In 2025 we discovered that schools who had the best experience with our Indigenous programs were schools that have already had some exposure to aboriginal led education.

To ensure that schools can make the most out of our Year-12 Rainbow's End Workshops and Writing about Country workshops we highly recommend this preliminary session with our team who can introduce general cultural education at Year-11 or even earlier. It is a huge socio-political issue that young Australians aren't engaging with Aboriginal culture often or early enough.

Cross cultural education is complicated and takes time. We strongly suggest this program choice to ensure your school and our Aboriginal educators feel safe in the workspace.



CREATIVE WORKSHOPS KEY FRAMEWORKS OF IDEAS

These programs give students access to writing tools used by real life artists. The workshops focus on enhancing and complimenting the work you do as teachers, and getting students excited about writing and creating.

In these workshops, students will be putting pen to paper. They will write several responses of short and medium length and one longer piece. This could be the foundation for work they use in their assessment.

The core concept is, to help them find their unique inner creative voices and give them the confidence to succeed at creating.

The workshop is broken into 3 main sections:

- 1) Breaking the ice and feeling confident
- 2)Experience & Using Mentor Texts
- 3) Developing Longer Pieces

The Mentor Texts are from your chosen area of Play, Country, Protest or Personal Journeys.




